Payment is due at the time of registration. No spaces will be held and telephone registration is not permitted. You may pay by cash, check or credit card.

Please Enroll Early!

Nothing hurts a program more than participants who wait until the last minute to enroll. There is a point when programs must be cancelled due to insufficient registration. To ensure a successful program, please enroll early!

Registration Deadline: One week prior to the start of a program.

Cancellation Policy: Classes and programs are subject to cancellation due to insufficient registration, building closings, holidays, weather or other reasons deemed necessary by the Department.

Make-up Classes: Classes or programs cancelled by the Parks & Recreation Department will be made up at a later date. Classes missed by the participants will not be made up.

Refund Policy: A full refund will be issued if the Department cancels a program. Requests for refunds must be made in writing at least FIVE business days prior to the start of programs. After the deadline, no refunds will be issued.

Non-Resident Fees: An additional fee is due for registrants living outside the Barnwell city limits. This fee may vary depending on the participant's age and activity.





The Lemon Park Sports Complex encompasses an area of 16+ acres. The complex includes four 200-foot fields in a clover-leaf design surrounding a Press Box/Concession Stand, a multi-purpose field which may be split into smaller fields for soccer or football, a 300-foot baseball field with Press Box, a T-ball field, walking trail and 2 playgrounds.

Playgrounds, walking trail and multi-purpose field are open daily from 8a – dusk



Park/Sport Field Reservations

Reservations for the use of parks and sport fields may be made in person at the City of Barnwell Parks & Recreation Department, 130 Main St. Reservations are accepted on a first-come, first served basis. Park Reservation Request Forms can be obtained on-line or at City Hall.

Use of Lemon Park Sports Fields may be reserved for a practice fee. Please contact the Parks & Recreation Department for these fees.

The City of Barnwell Park & Recreation Department programs take precedence over all reservations.

- Field rental reservations are final upon completion of the application, payment and the necessary approvals. Reservations made after 12:00 will not receive field preparations.
- There will be no rain dates or refunds issued for any reason other than cancellation by BPRD.
- All permits are non-transferable. The permit holder is responsible for the conduct of his/her group. Failure to comply will void the permit. The original Field Permit must be in possession of the group leader at the field site.
- Possession of Alcoholic beverages or illegal substances is prohibited in City of Barnwell Parks. No tobacco products are allowed.
- No Soft Toss allowed.
- Amplification of any kind must comply with City code and receive prior approval by BPRD.
- Please park cars in designated areas. Do not park or drive on grass areas, sidewalks or trails.
- All games or events at Lemon Park must end by 10:30 pm.
- Stakes are not allowed to be used anywhere in the fields.
- If issues arise (i.e.: non-permitted group will not relinquish park amenity) or maintenance emergencies occur and a park & recreation staff member is not present onsite, please contact the Barnwell County Dispatch at (803).541.1080.

It is understood that no person, group or organization has any vested right to the exclusive use of park property. The use of any/all park property is subject to availability and approval by the City of Barnwell Parks & Recreation Department, subject to the policies, rules and guidelines of the City of Barnwell Parks & Recreation Department. All requests and paperwork related to it must be received by the Department before the requested usage date. It is understood that Department-sponsored activities have priority over all other activities in using park facilities and this permit is subject to cancellation in the event of an emergency. If a facility rental permit is granted, the users agree to be responsible for any accidents or injuries sustained by any person attending or participating in the program or activity at the park, and to be responsible for replacement in case any damage or loss is incurred. A certificate of insurance naming the City of Barnwell as an additional insured may be required. It is agreed and understood the City of Barnwell will assume no liability for the use of any facilities or equipment. The applicant agrees to hold the City of Barnwell harmless from any incident or injury (including death), directly or indirectly, resulting from the use of the city facility or equipment. All users agree to adhere to the Rules, applicable federal, state and local laws, and any specific guidelines outlined in the facility reservation permit. I understand that alcoholic beverages are not allowed on park property. The undersigned hereby acknowledge receipt of the rules. I have read the Terms and Conditions and Park Rules and, as representative of the group making this request, I do agree to abide by these rules.

1. Park rental reservations are final upon completion of the application, payment and the necessary approvals.
2. There will be no rain dates or refunds issued for any reason other than cancellation by BPRD.
3. All permits are non-transferable. The permit holder is responsible for the conduct of his/her group. Failure to comply will void the permit. The original Park Permit must be in possession of the group leader at the park site.
4. Possession of Alcoholic beverages or illegal substances is prohibited in City of Barnwell Parks.
5. All trash must be disposed of in the proper receptacles.
6. Amplification of any kind must comply with City code and receive prior approval by BPRD.
7. Please park cars in designated areas. Do not park or drive on grass areas, sidewalks or trails.
8. All fires are to be built only in grills. Grills may not be used directly under a picnic shelter.
9. The removal of tables or grills from the park is not permitted.
10. The use of tape, glue, nails, tacks, screws, staples, or other fasteners that may scratch or otherwise damage surfaces of the shelter/gazebo are prohibited.
11. Stakes are not allowed to be used anywhere in the parks.
12. If issues arise (i.e.: non-permitted group will not relinquish park amenity) or maintenance emergencies occur and a park & recreation staff member is not present onsite, please contact the Barnwell County Dispatch at (803).541.1080.
